

Shape Energy Workshop

22nd of February 2018

Venue: Holiday Inn Lisbon-Continental (Lisbon)

Within the scope of the SHAPE ENERGY project and the REHABILITE project, Lisbon E-Nova will hold a workshop entitled "**Innovative instruments to support energy efficiency in urban rehabilitation in Lisbon**". The aim of the session is to promote initiatives to support energy efficiency and urban renewal, as well as identifying barriers and solutions to leverage innovative financial mechanisms, such as the recently launched IFRRU (Financial Instrument for Urban Rehabilitation and Urbanization), to explore challenges to find new solutions and find synergies for future programmes and incentives. In the morning, the workshop is informative and intended for the general public. In the afternoon, a focus group will be organized with the participation of a group of key actors (about 25 people).

Urban rehabilitation is an intervention priority of the Lisbon City Council, based on the Lisbon Rehabilitation Strategy 2011-2024, in articulation with other municipal policies in the areas of urbanism, housing, social action, culture, mobility, urban environment, economy, real estate and finance.

Increasing the overall rate of energy efficiency improvement and making cities and communities inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable are part of Lisbon's ambitions for the consolidation of a smart city focused on energy sustainability. In this context, the IFRRU (the Financial Instrument for Urban Rehabilitation and Revitalization), has been recently launched, covering the entire national territory and bringing together various funding sources. It intends to support and finance urban rehabilitation and energy efficiency with loans with more favourable conditions for the promoters.

At the national and local levels, other programmes are also under study to encourage urban rehabilitation and energy efficiency, and there are other public and private alternatives, such as the Casa Eficiente 2020 Programme (also recently launched) and the REHABILITE project that promotes rehabilitation through the use of European investment funds, by identifying and using successful financial instruments to break down investment barriers to rehabilitate private housing and public buildings.
